Reading: Our latest text for this term is *'Peanut Jones and the Illustrated City'* by Rob Biddulph.

English: We will be reading Peanut Jones and writing a diary entry during the first half term. This will help us to maintain a viewpoint in our writing as we write from Peanut's point of view. After that, we will be focusing on using effective language to describe peculiar creatures, similar to the ones that feature in our text.

Maths: This term in maths, we will be starting off with our White Rose Multiplication and Division B unit, to consolidate multiplication facts and learn written strategies.

Science: Our next unit is states of matter! We will be discussing solids, liquids and gases and then conducting a few investigations along the course of the topic.

Geography: This unit is called *'Misty Mountain, Winding River'* and the children will be learning all about the characteristics and features of rivers and mountain ranges around the world.

Art: This term we will be teaching the children about the techniques that artists use when composing landscape images, such as colour and atmosphere.

DT: Our topic this term is called *'Functional and Fancy Fabrics'* and will be teaching children about home furnishings and the significant designer William Morris. They will learn techniques for decorating fabric, including block printing, hemming and embroidery.

Similarly to Autumn Term, homework will be set on Atom Learning. Login details have been sent home previously but please let us know if you need any assistance with this.

Maths: Set every Monday, due in Friday. As mentioned above, the children are also encouraged to be accessing TT Rockstars!

English: set on Wednesdays, due in the following Tuesday.

Reading: The children should also be reading at home at least three times a week and this can then be written in their reading diaries. These will be collected and checked every Monday by the class teacher.

Every week the children will be in a TT Rockstar battle with another class in the school, so participation is strongly encouraged!

Please note that there is no outdoor learning this term and instead the children will need their normal PE kits in all week for two sessions of PE instead.
