# Important! Accessing 30 hours childcare or Tax-Free Childcare, or wanting to apply to start in January 2023?

If your child is receiving 30 hours childcare or Tax-Free Childcare. make sure you re-confirm your information; or apply for the funding before the 31 December 2022 to ensure that your child receives their entitlement with no gaps or delays from January 2023.

# **REMINDER - Starting School in 2023**



Applications are open for parents to apply for their child (born between 01 September 2018 – 31 August 2019) to start school in September 2023. The closing date for applications is 15 January 2023.

Parents can apply online via the Hampshire County Council website: www.hants.gov.uk/educationandlearning/admissions. Paper forms will also be available from any Hampshire primary or infant school on request.

Also taking place is the Hampshire County Council's School Admission Arrangements Consultation 2024-25, and parents are invited to take part.
