Reusable Nappies discount scheme expanded

Since the Reusable Nappies discount scheme launched in September 2022, over 600 Hampshire families have registered online for a 15% discount on reusable nappies and related products!

By visiting <u>Reusable nappies | Hampshire County Council (hants.gov.uk)</u>, residents of Hampshire, Southampton and Portsmouth can obtain a 15% discount code to spend with their supplier of choice.

We now have an even greater range of products, with 12 suppliers offering a discount.

Orion's Cloth Nappies also stock reusable nappies for older children, beyond the typical nappy wearing period.

Nappy libraries are a great way to 'try before you buy' by renting a reusable nappy kit to suit your needs. The libraries often run advice sessions or groups so you can talk to other parents trying reusable nappies.
