Starting School in 2024



From 1 November 2023, applications will open for parents to apply for their child (born between 01 September 2019 – 31 August 2020) to start school in September 2024. The closing date for applications is 15 January 2024.

Parents will be able to apply online from 1 November via the Hampshire County Council website: www.hants.gov.uk/educationandlearning/admissions. Paper forms

will also be available from any Hampshire primary or infant school on request from the same date.
