A notice for parents and carers: 15% discount on Reusable Nappies for Hampshire residents

On **7 September** Hampshire County Council, Southampton City Council and Portsmouth City Council are launching a new scheme providing Hampshire residents with a **15% discount** on reusable nappies.

It is estimated that each child will go through as many as 4,000 nappies by age two and a half. As a result, disposable nappies make up around 6% of the average rubbish bin in Hampshire homes. By switching to reusables, parents and carers can make a big impact and reduce how much waste they throw away.

Hampshire County Council recognises that the initial cost of reusables can be a barrier for some families, which is why we have partnered with six retailers, providing ample choice of products to suit everybody's needs at a discounted price.

What you need to do:

1. Visit <https://www.hants.gov.uk/reusable-nappies> (available from 7 September)
2. Input your postcode
3. Select your address
4. Retrieve your discount code and make a note of the expiry date
5. Spend with your supplier of choice
